DAY 1: 05/09/2020

Inaugural ceremony and Opening of the program

Removal of Old stock:

The Secretary, TSWREIS, Hyderabad have taken a decision to conduct “**SWACHH GURUKUL**” in all the TSWREIS institutions from **5/9/2022 to 11/09/2022**.

As a part of this program, the Secretary has instructed to segregate the waste and disposable items like **Paper wastes, Plastic wastes and Iron wastes**.

Accordingly the Day1- committee Smt **P.Arpitha, A.Neeraja, K.Jhansi and K.Pragathi** under the chairmanship of principal & vice chairmanship of vice principal, the waste materials were weighed.

The details are following:-

- 1) Iron wastes chairs, Tube light frames and Trunk boxes - 65kgs
- 2) Plastic waste - 17kgs
- 3) Paper waste – Papers/Records -2872kgs

TOTAL – 2,954 Kgs

The same information submitted to the **Secretary, TSWREIS, Hyderabad** through Google sheet and Excel form to RC, HRR (west) too.

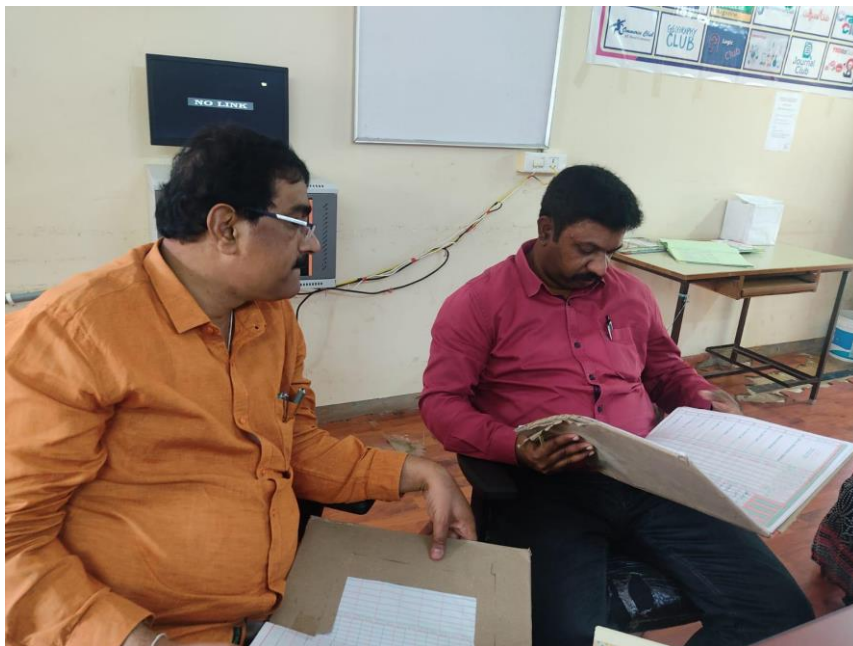
